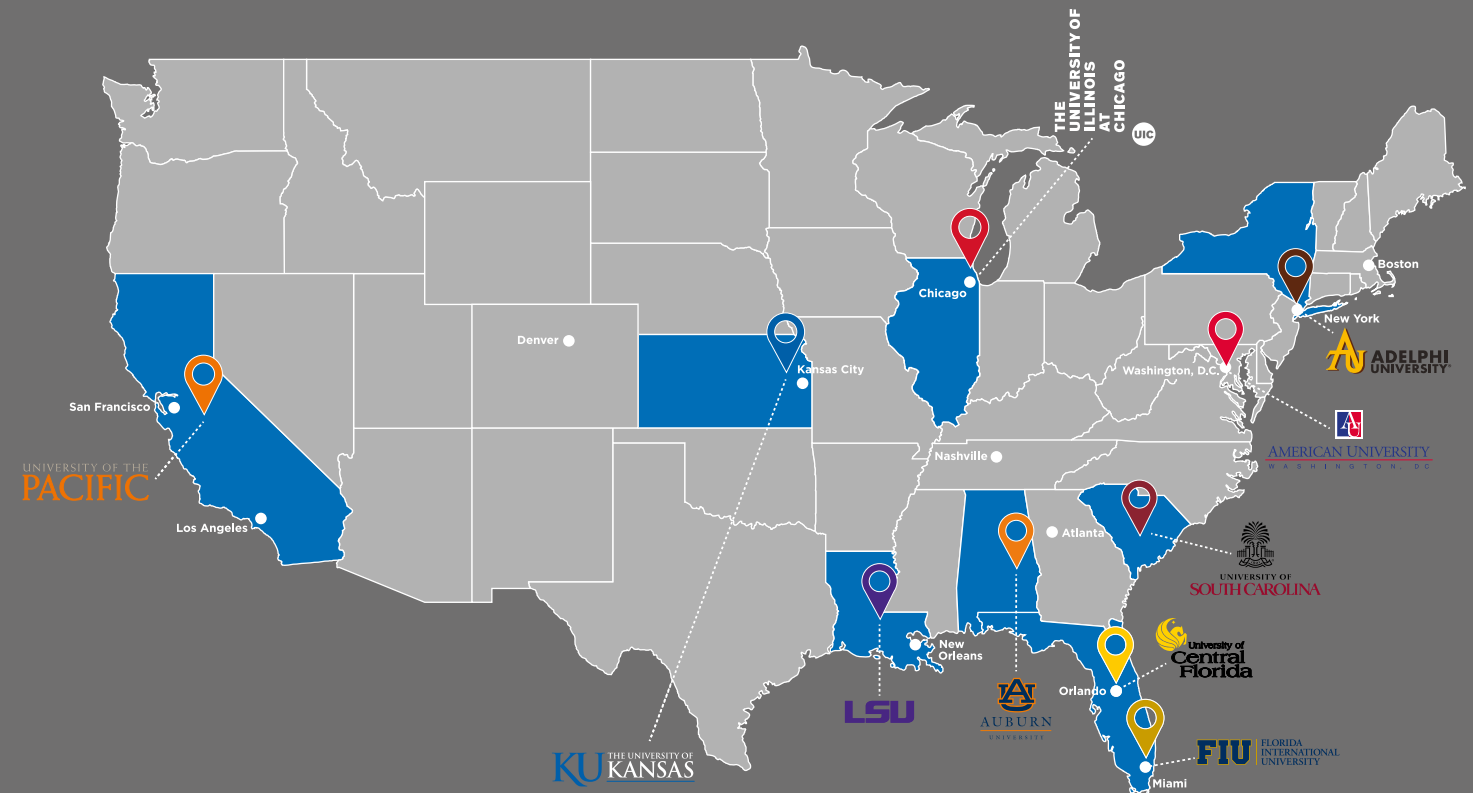


Emphasis on Global Citizenship

Signature Student Experience

Our member universities' programs have at their heart a curriculum that is both challenging and engaging, driven by the goal of creating a world-class, meaningful student experience.



Career Accelerator

Through the Career Accelerator, students enhance their employability, gain skills to advance their academic performance and access opportunities for real-world work placement, either during their degree or upon graduation.

The International Accelerator is the first year of a student's studies at an IUA member university. Through their first year, students study a combination of core and subject-specific modules, developing study skills and subject knowledge across the academic areas most relevant to their chosen degree. The International Accelerator broadens educational opportunities for students across the globe and helps its member university become a model for international student success and opportunity. Both Undergraduate Accelerator programs and Master's Accelerator programs are offered through the International Accelerator.

The Undergraduate Accelerator comprises three distinct first-year programs for international students entering their Undergraduate studies at a university in the United States. A student's program track is determined by fit, academic background, level of English-language proficiency and personal preference, and programs can be two or three semesters long. Upon completion of the Undergraduate Accelerator, students progress into their second year of study at the member university. All undergraduate students are offered intensive career planning and preparation through the co-curricular Career Accelerator, with the opportunity to receive internship placement support at the conclusion of the program.

The Master's Accelerator offers a variety of program tracks for students entering a master's degree program in the United States, all of which include co-curricular professional preparation for a student's intended career path. Master's Accelerator program tracks offered by member universities vary in number and duration, and each track includes a different

level of English-language and academic support. The number of credits a student earns during the Master's Accelerator is dependent on the member university, program track and master's degree program. Upon completion of the Master's Accelerator, students continue at the member university to pursue the remaining credits required to earn their master's degree.

All International Accelerator programs offer the following:

FLEXIBILITY — With the U.S. academic model, students can change majors and explore what interests them, customize their educational experience and pursue their dreams.

DEDICATED SUPPORT SERVICES TEAM — Students and their families benefit from advisors to help them with every step of the process, from application to getting their visa to packing for the airport.

SMALL CLASS SIZES — Students are given more individual attention and tailored support because of our small classes.

PRIORITY ACCESS — Students have priority access to a selection of courses hand picked by their academic advisor, which are tailored to their interests and career goals.

DEDICATED MENTORS — Students find success with coaches and mentors that help ensure they have access to the resources they need to get the most out of their education and their experience in the United States.

Connecting a student's professional aspirations with their academic degree program is core to the IUA signature student experience. Through the Career Accelerator, students not only explore their career opportunities, they take part in seminars, networking events, one-on-one coaching and even internships designed to set each student apart.

Career Accelerator

The Career Accelerator gives students the skills and knowledge to excel professionally, whether they are searching for their career path, exploring postgraduate degree programs, preparing to lead their family's business or planning to start their own company. Designed exclusively for international students, it features unique workshops, real-world experiences, cross-cultural group work and skills-based training.

The Career Accelerator offers five different tracks:

- **College-to-Career** for students pursuing an internship (or co-op) experience during their college years and/or seeking general preparation for their postgraduate job search.
- **Advanced Degree Preparation** for students who intend to directly pursue a master's or doctorate degree.
- **Sponsored Business Development** for students participating in a corporate scholarship program with activities customized to the sponsoring company and/or industry.

- **Family Business Development** for students pursuing a degree to assist with the strengthening and expansion of a family-owned business.

- **Entrepreneurship** for students intending to start, own, run and manage their own business after graduation.

Internship Placement Assistance

Upon successful completion of the Career Accelerator, students have the opportunity to receive internship placement assistance. Participants will gain access to exclusive internships at leading global corporations, based on their track and professional goals. For example, an Entrepreneurship Track student might intern for a tech startup in Silicon Valley, while a Sponsored Business Development Track student might intern for a multinational corporation such as Google, Deloitte, ExxonMobil or Microsoft.

2. RECEIVE NOTIFICATION OF CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

Qualified students will receive a conditional offer of admission. The offer letter will outline conditions that must be fulfilled before receiving a formal offer of admission.

3. FULFILL CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Conditions of admission include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Proof of English-language ability
- I-20 request form
- Certificate of Finance form
- Financial documentation covering the full amount listed on the Certificate of Finance
- Deposit that is listed on your conditional offer

NOTE: If you are currently studying in the U.S. and will be transferring your I-20, you will also need to submit the current I-20 and the Transfer-in Form.

4. RECEIVE YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION

You will then receive a packet that includes all the required documents to apply for your visa. If you are a sponsored student, you can now use your offer of admission to obtain your full financial guarantee from your sponsorship entity. Once you submit the financial guarantee, you will receive your I-20.

- Submit your ID photo (American only)
